A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO IMPOSE DEADLINES ON THE REPORT OF FIRE CONDITIONS
AND TO PROVIDE THAT UNALLOCATED FUNDS ESCHEAT TO THE GENERAL FUND.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 58-84-46 reads as rewritten:

"§ 58-84-46. Certification to Commissioner.

On or before October 31 of each year the clerk or finance officer of each city or county that has a local board of trustees under G.S. 58-84-30 shall file a certificate of eligibility with the Commissioner. The certificate shall be known as the "Report of Fire Conditions" and shall contain information prescribed by administrative rule adopted by the Commissioner. If the certificate is not filed with the Commissioner on or before January 31 November 30 in the ensuing of that year:

- (1) The city or county that failed to file the certificate shall forfeit the payment next due to be paid to its board of trustees.
- (2) The Commissioner shall pay over that amount to the treasurer of the North Carolina State Firemen's Association. General Fund.
- 18 (3) That amount shall constitute a part of the Firemen's Relief Fund."
- 19 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
