4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 18B of the General Statutes is amended by adding a	
6	new section to read:	
7	7 " <u>§ 18B-101A. Commission may issue permits statewide.</u>	
8	(a) Effective January 1, 2005, the Commission may issue permits to qualified	
9	applicants throughout the State.	
10	(b) The local governing body of a jurisdiction shall have the option to determine	
11	that no permits shall be issued by the Commission in that jurisdiction by passing a	
12	resolution no later than October 1, 2004. If a county board of commissioners passes a	
13	prohibition resolution, no permits shall be issued by the Commission in the	
14	unincorporated area of the county. If a city council passes a prohibition resolution, no	
15	permits shall be issued by the Commission within the corporate limits of the	
16	municipality. All resolutions passed pursuant to this subsection shall be filed with the	
17	Alcoholic Beverage Control Commission.	
18	(c) Once a governing body has voted to prohibit the issuance of permits by the	
19	Commission within the jurisdiction, only an election by the registered citizens of that	
20	jurisdiction, conducted in accordance with G.S. 18B-601, can authorize the Commission	
21	to issue permits in that jurisdiction.	
22	(d) All permits issued by the Commission prior to June 30, 2004, pursuant to the	
23	provisions of this Chapter shall remain in effect even if a governing body votes,	
24	pursuant to subsection (b) of this section, to prohibit the issuance of permits by the	
25	5 <u>Commission.</u>	
26	(e) All local acts, rules, and provisions of this Chapter in conflict with this	
27	section are invalid and may not be enforced."
