42 **SECTION 2.** The Governor shall appoint the additional district court judges
43 for District Court District 14 authorized by Section 1 of this act. Successors shall be

1 elected in the 2004 general election for four-year terms commencing the first Monday in
2 December 2004.

3 **SECTION 3.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial
4 Department the sum of two hundred nine thousand two hundred dollars (\$209,200) for
5 the 2003-2004 fiscal year and the sum of three hundred two thousand three hundred
6 twenty-four dollars (\$302,324) for the 2004-2005 fiscal year to establish two new
7 district court judge positions and two new deputy clerk positions.

8 **SECTION 4.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2003, or the date upon
9 which the act is approved under section 5 of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, whichever
10 is later.
