JUDGES FOR DISTRICT COURT DISTRICT 14.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 7A-133(a) reads as rewritten:

"(a) Each district court district shall have the numbers of judges as set forth in the following table:

SECTION 2. The Governor shall appoint the additional district court judges for District Court District 14 authorized by Section 1 of this act. Successors shall be

elected in the 2004 general election for four-year terms commencing the first Monday in
December 2004.

SECTION 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial Department the sum of two hundred nine thousand two hundred dollars (\$209,200) for the 2003-2004 fiscal year and the sum of three hundred two thousand three hundred twenty-four dollars (\$302,324) for the 2004-2005 fiscal year to establish two new district court judge positions and two new deputy clerk positions.

SECTION 4. This act becomes effective December 1, 2003, or the date upon which the act is approved under section 5 of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, whichever is later.
