AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE COMMISSION OF SEAFOOD AND AQUACULTURE TO CONDUCT VARIOUS STUDING RELATED TO MARINE FISHERIES. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
SECTION 1. The Joint Legislative Commission on Seafood	and
Aquaculture may study any of the following: (1) The statutory changes recommended by the Marine Fisher Commission regarding shellfish and their cultivation. In its conduct this study, the Joint Legislative Commission on Seafood a Aquaculture may specifically consider recommendations in the Aug 2001, Hard Clam Fishery Management Plan; recommendations in August 2001, Oyster Fishery Management Plan; and ot recommendations of the Marine Fisheries Commission related to shellfish leasing program. (2) Whether to amend the maximum sustainable yield fisher	ries t of and gust the ther the
management standard. (3) The establishment of a violation points system for marine fisher licenses.	
(4) Whether and to what extent the enforcement authority of mar fisheries inspectors should be expanded.	rine
(5) Whether to allow marine fisheries inspectors to accept delegation law enforcement powers from the National Marine Fisheries Service	
SECTION 2. The Joint Legislative Commission on Seafood a Aquaculture may request the assistance of the Division of Marine Fisheries of Department of Environment and Natural Resources and any other State agent	and the
necessary to conduct any of the studies authorized by this act.	

SECTION 3. The Joint Legislative Commission on Seafood and Aquaculture shall report its findings and recommendations, if any, including any legislative proposals, to the 2004 Regular Session of the 2003 General Assembly.

SECTION 4. This act is effective when it becomes law.
