| 3 | Whereas, in 1751, Cane Creek Meetinghouse served as a place of worship for |
| 4 | Quaker families living in both the Snow Camp area and the Rocky River community; |
| 5 | and |
| 6 | Whereas, because six miles separated these two communities, some Rocky |
| 7 | River families expressed a desire to have their own place of worship; and |
| 8 | Whereas, in 1753, some of these Rocky River families began meeting in the |
| 9 | home of David Vestal, forming the Rocky River Friends; and |
| 10 | Whereas, in 1793, land was transferred from David Vestal to the Trustees of |
| 11 | the Rocky River Friends Meetinghouse; and |
| 12 | Whereas, over the years, several churches were built to accommodate the |
| 13 | Rocky River congregation; and |
| 14 | Whereas, the current Rocky River Friends Church was built in 1926; and |
| 15 | Whereas, for 250 years, the Rocky River Friends Church has served as a |
| 16 | place of worship for the community and surrounding area; Now, therefore, |
| 17 | Be it resolved by the Senate: |
| 18 | SECTION 1. The Senate congratulates the Rocky River Friends Church on |
| 19 | its 250 th anniversary. |
| 20 | SECTION 2. The Principal Clerk shall transmit a certified copy of this |
