**SECTION 1.** The permanent rules of the 2003 Regular Session, with the following amendments, are the rules governing the Reconvened 2003 Regular Session of the General Assembly:

## Rule 40.1. Limitation on resolutions and bills.

The only resolutions that may be introduced or considered in the Senate are resolutions adjourning the Reconvened Session. As provided by the Constitution, no bill may be considered in the Senate other than House Bill 917, AN ACT TO CONFORM

- may be considered in the Senate other than House Bill 917, AN ACT TO CONFORM THE LAWS RELATED TO PERMISSIBLE INTEREST RATES FOR HOME LOANS
- 13 SECURED BY FIRST MORTGAGES, AND TO AUTHORIZE THE LEGISLATIVE
- 14 RESEARCH COMMISSION TO STUDY ISSUES RELATED TO BANKING AND
- 15 LENDING LAWS. This rule may not be suspended.
- 16 **Rule 59.** (Reserved).
- SECTION 2. This resolution is effective upon adoption, but applies only to the Reconvened Session.
