A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE TOWN OF SUNSET BEACH IS AN EMPLOYING UNIT UNDER THE TEACHERS' AND STATE EMPLOYEES' COMPREHENSIVE MAJOR MEDICAL PLAN.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** G.S. 135-40.1(6) reads as rewritten:

"(6) Employing Unit. – A North Carolina School System; Community College; State Department, Agency or Institution; Administrative Office of the Courts; or Association or Examining Board whose employees are eligible for membership in a State-Supported Retirement System. An employing unit also shall mean a charter school in accordance with Part 6A of Chapter 115C of the General Statutes whose board of directors elects to become a participating employer in the Plan under G.S. 135-40.3A. An employing unit also means a city, town, or village. Bona fide fire departments, rescue or emergency medical service squads, and national guard units are deemed to be employing units for the purpose of providing benefits under this Article."

**SECTION 2.** This act applies to the Town of Sunset Beach only.

**SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2004.
