A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  AN ACT TO REPEAL THE SUNSET ON THE LONG-TERM CARE INSURANCE TAX CREDIT.  The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:  SECTION 1. Section 29A.6(d) of S.L. 1998-212 reads as rewritten:  "(d) Subsection (a) of this section is effective for taxable years beginning on or after January 1, 1999, and expires for taxable years beginning on or after January 1, 2004.  January 1, 1999. The remainder of this section is effective when it becomes law.  G.S. 105-160.3(b)(7), as enacted by this act, is repealed effective for taxable years beginning on or after January 1, 2004."		
<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act becomes effective for taxable years beginning on or		

after January 1, 2004.
