3	The General As	sembly of North Carolina enacts:
4	SECT	FION 1. G.S. 153A-335, as it applies to Pitt County, reads as rewritten:
5	"§ 153A-335. "	Subdivision'' defined.
6	For purpose	s of this Part, "subdivision" means all divisions of a tract or parcel of
7	land into two or	r more lots, building sites, or other divisions for the purpose of sale or
8	building development (whether immediate or future) and includes all division of land	
9	involving the de	edication of a new street or a change in existing streets; however, the
10	following is not included within this definition and is not subject to any regulations	
11	enacted pursuan	t to this Part:
12	(1)	The combination or recombination of portions of previously
13		subdivided and recorded lots if the total number of lots is not increased
14		and the resultant lots are equal to or exceed the standards of the county
15		as shown in its subdivision regulations;
16	(2)	The division of land into parcels greater than 10 acres if no street
17		right-of-way dedication is involved;
18	(3)	The public acquisition by purchase of strips of land for widening or
19		opening streets or for public transportation system corridors; and
20	(4)	The division of a tract in single ownership the entire area of which is
21		no greater than two acres into not more than three lots, if no street
22		right-of-way dedication is involved and if the resultant lots are equal to
23		or exceed the standards of the county as shown by its subdivision
24		regulations.regulations;
25	<u>(5)</u>	The division of a tract among heirs of a deceased person as part of the
26		settlement of the deceased person's estate by action of a will or other
27		legal proceeding; and
28	<u>(6)</u>	The division of land by any method of transfer from a grantor to a
29		grantee (or grantees) who is a member of the grantor's immediate

1	family, solely for the residential use of the grantee (or grantees). For
2	the purposes of this section, the term "immediate family" shall include
3	only direct lineal descendants (children and grandchildren) and direct
4	lineal ascendants (father, mother, grandfather, and grandmother)."
5	SECTION 2. This act applies to Pitt County only.
6	SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
