AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE CHILD WELFARE COLLABORATIVE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services the sum of two million eight hundred thousand dollars (\$2,800,000) for the 2004-2005 fiscal year to be allocated to the Child Welfare Collaborative, which is a joint effort of the North Carolina Social Work

10 Association of County Directors, and the North Carolina Chapter of the National

11 Association of Social Workers, the purpose of which is to expand social work programs

in higher education and thereby increase the number of persons holding Bachelors of

in local departments of social services.
