A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO OUR CHILDREN'S PLACE, A NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION THAT PROVIDES SERVICES FOR CERTAIN INCARCERATED MOTHERS AND THEIR AT-RISK CHILDREN.

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Correction the sum of three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) for the 2004-2005 fiscal year for Our Children's Place, a nonprofit organization that serves incarcerated women and their at-risk children. The funds shall be used for the completion of the design and the construction documents for a residential rehabilitation facility that will provide intensive education and treatment services for nonviolent minimum custody inmate mothers and high quality early childhood development services for the children of those inmate mothers.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2004.
