Referred to: A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CONSTRUCTION AND THE FINANCING, WITHOUT APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE GENERAL FUND, OF CERTAIN **PROJECTS CONSTITUENT** CAPITAL **IMPROVEMENTS** OF THE INSTITUTIONS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Purpose. – The purpose of this act is: (i) to authorize the construction by certain constituent institutions of The University of North Carolina of the capital improvements projects listed in the act for the respective institutions, and (ii) to authorize the financing of these projects with funds available to the institutions from gifts, grants, receipts, self-liquidating indebtedness, or other funds, or any combination of these funds, but not including funds appropriated from the General Fund of the State. **SECTION 2.** The capital improvements projects, and their respective costs, authorized by this act to be constructed and financed as provided in Section 1 of this act including by revenue bonds, by special obligations bonds as authorized in Section 6 of this act, or by both are as follows: **Appalachian State University** Central Dining Facility – Supplement \$2,000,000 2 **East Carolina University** Tyler & Fletcher Residence Halls – Air Conditioning and Window Upgrades 3,250,000 North Carolina A&T State University 3

SECTION 5. At the request of the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina and upon determining that it is in the best interest of the State to do so, the Director of the Budget may authorize an increase or decrease in the cost of, or a change in the method of funding, the projects authorized by this act, except that the Director of the Budget shall not authorize debt financing of the projects authorized in Section 4 of this act. Before authorizing a change in cost or funding, the Director of the Budget shall consult with the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations.

SECTION 6. Pursuant to G.S. 116D-26, the Board of Governors may issue, subject to the approval of the Director of the Budget, at one time or from time to time, special obligation bonds of the Board of Governors for the purpose of paying all or any part of the cost of acquiring, constructing, or providing for the projects authorized by Sections 2 and 3 of this act. The maximum principal amount of bonds to be issued shall not exceed the specified project costs in Sections 2 and 3 of this act plus twenty million dollars (\$20,000,000) for related additional costs, such as issuance expenses, funding of reserve funds, and capitalized interest.

1 **SECTION 7.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
