15	<u>(1)</u>	With the approval of the General Assembly by a two-thirds vote of the									
16		members voting in each house.									
17	<u>(2)</u>	With the approval of the North Carolina Historical Commission by a									
18		two-thirds vote of the members voting at a regularly scheduled									
19		meeting.									
20	<u>(3)</u>	Upon the authority of the public or private body responsible for the									
21		protection, preservation, upkeep, and care of these monuments,									
22		memorials, plaques, markers, or historic flag displays. Any monument,
