2	AN ACT TO EXPAND THE TEACHING FELLOWS PROGRAM TO ALL
3	CAMPUSES OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA THAT OFFER
4	TEACHER TRAINING PROGRAMS.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1. G.S. 115C-363.23A(b) reads as rewritten:
7	"(b) The Commission shall administer the program in cooperation with <u>each of the</u>
8	teacher training institutions at The University of North Carolina and with other teacher
9	training institutions selected by the Commission. Beginning with the 2004-2005
10	academic year, each of the 15 constituent institutions of The University of North
11	Carolina with a teacher training program and each other teacher training institution
12	selected by the Commission shall receive an equal number of Teaching Fellows.
13	Teaching Fellows should be exposed to a range of extra-curricular activities while in
14	college. These activities should be geared to instilling a strong motivation not only to
15	remain in teaching but to provide leadership for tomorrow's schools."
16	SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of
17	Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of two hundred twenty-five
18	thousand dollars (\$225,000) for the 2004-2005 fiscal year to provide start-up funds to
19	the three campuses of The University of North Carolina that currently are not
20	participating in the Teaching Fellows Program.
21	SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2004.
