A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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2 AN ACT TO REMOVE THE SUNSET ON THE LAW PROVIDING THAT
3 CERTAIN SECONDARY SUPPLIERS OF ELECTRIC SERVICE MAY
4 FURNISH SERVICE WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF A CITY WITH
5 WRITTEN CONSENT FROM THE CITY, ALLOWING THE MEMBERS OF AN
6 ELECTRIC MEMBERSHIP CORPORATION TO VOTE BY PROXY ON
7 DECISIONS TO ENCUMBER CORPORATE PROPERTY OR TO DISSOLVE
8 THE CORPORATION, AND MAKING TECHNICAL CHANGES TO THE LAW
9 REGARDING MUNICIPAL ELECTRIC SERVICE.

10 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

11 **SECTION 1.** Section 6 of Chapter 346 of the 1997 Session Laws, as
12 amended by S.L. 1999-111, reads as rewritten:

13 **"Section 6.** This act is effective when it becomes law and applies only to
14 annexations or incorporations that occur on or after the effective date. ~~This act expires~~
15 ~~on December 31, 2003.~~"

16 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
