The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
SECTION 1. G.S. 136-69 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:		
"(a1) When any person who owns land that previously had access to a public		
roadway is deprived of access as a result of the relocation of the public roadway by the		

Department of Transportation and now has access to a public roadway only across and

through intervening private property, the person may petition for the opening of a

cartway or like easement by instituting a special proceeding pursuant to G.S. 136-68."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
