AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND
TRANSPORTATION NEEDS OF THE INTERNATIONAL HOME
FURNISHINGS MARKET.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the
Department of Commerce the sum of two million five hundred thousand dollars
(\$2,500,000) for the 2003-2004 fiscal year and the sum of five hundred thousand dollars
(\$500,000) for the 2004-2005 fiscal year for the International Home Furnishings
Market. These funds shall be allocated as follows:
(1) \$2,000,000 for the 2003-2004 fiscal year to enhance and improve the
Market's transportation terminal.
(2) \$500,000 for the 2003-2004 fiscal year and \$500,000 for the
2004-2005 fiscal year to provide shuttle service to the Market's 80,000

- 2004-2005 fiscal year to provide shuttle service to the Market's 80,000 annual visitors.
- **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2003.
