10	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
11	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 130A-4 reads as rewritten:
12	"§ 130A-4. Administration.
13	(a) Except as provided in subsection (c) and subsections (e) through (i) of this
14	section, the Secretary shall administer and enforce the provisions of this Chapter and the
15	rules of the Commission. A local health director shall administer the programs of the
16	local health department and enforce the rules of the local board of health.
17	(b) When Subject to subsection (a) of this section, when requested by the
18	Secretary, a local health department shall enforce the rules of the Commission under the
19	supervision of the Department. The local health department shall utilize local staff
20	authorized by the Department to enforce the specific rules.
21	(c) The Secretary of Environment and Natural Resources shall administer and
22	enforce the provisions of Articles 8, 9, 10, 11, and 12 of this Chapter and the rules of the
23	Commission.
24	(d) When Subject to subsection (c) of this section, when requested by the
25	Secretary of Environment and Natural Resources, a local health department shall
26	enforce the rules of the Commission under the supervision of the Department of
27	Environment and Natural Resources. The local health department shall utilize local staff

authorized by the Department of Environment and Natural Resources to enforce the 1 2 specific rules. 3 The Secretary of Environment and Natural Resources shall administer and (e) enforce the provisions of Articles 8 and 11 of this Chapter and the rules of the 4 5 Commission. Except as provided under subsections (g) through (i) of this section, a 6 local health department shall enforce the rules of the Commission under the supervision 7 of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources when requested by the Secretary of Environment and Natural Resources, and the local health department shall 8 9 utilize local staff authorized by the Department of Environment and Natural Resources 10 to enforce the specific rules. In a local health department that has an environmental health supervisor, an 11 (f)12 environmental health supervisor who has been authorized under this section to enforce the rules of the Commission for a specific environmental health program under Article 8 13 14 or Article 11 of this Chapter for at least the three previous years may authorize a new 15 employee of that local health department to enforce the rules of the Commission for that specific program for that local health department so long as the employee has 16 17 successfully completed the training administered by the Department of Environment 18 and Natural Resources. In a local health department that does not have any environmental health supervisor, the environmental health coordinator for that local 19 20 health department who has been authorized under this section to enforce the rules of the 21 Commission for a specific environmental health program under Article 8 or Article 11 of this Chapter for at least the three previous years may authorize a new employee of 22 23 that local health department to enforce the rules of the Commission for that specific 24 program for that local health department so long as the employee has successfully completed the training administered by the Department of Environment and Natural 25 Resources. The local health department shall use the same process and the same forms 26 that the Department of Environment and Natural Resources uses in authorizing 27 employees to enforce rules under subsection (d) of this section. A local health 28 29 department may request the Department of Environment and Natural Resources to have 30 regional environmental health specialists authorize new employees to enforce the rules of specific programs under Article 8 or Article 11 of this Chapter through the regional 31 32 office for that local health department. An environmental health specialist in a local health department who is 33 (g) authorized under this section to enforce the rules of the Commission for a specific 34 35 program under Article 8 or Article 11 of this Chapter for that local health department and who has maintained registration as a sanitarian under Article 4 of Chapter 90A of 36 the General Statutes may change employment to another local health department 37 38 without obtaining reauthorization or retraining in that specific program. An environmental health employee of the Department of Environment and 39 (h) Natural Resources may, for any local health department, be authorized to enforce the 40 rules for the specific program under Article 8 or Article 11 of this Chapter in which the 41 42 employee worked previously without obtaining retraining if the employee satisfies all of the following: 43
