5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1. G.S. 115C-81(h1)(2) reads as rewritten:
7	"(h1) In addition to the instruction under subsection (h) of this section, local boards
8	of education are encouraged to include instruction on the following responsibilities:
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10	(2) Responsibility for school safety. – Helping to create a harmonious
11	school atmosphere that is free from threats, weapons, and violent or
12	disruptive behavior; cultivate an orderly learning environment in
13	which students and school personnel feel safe and secure; and
14	encourage the resolution of conflicts and disagreements through
15	peaceful means including peer mediation. Instruction in this
16	responsibility should include a consistent and age-appropriate
17	antiviolence message and a conflict resolution component for students
18	in kindergarten through twelfth grade. These messages should include
19	media-awareness education to help children recognize stereotypes and
20	messages portraying violence. This approach should be promoted in all
21	public and charter schools.
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23	SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
