| 5  | The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:  |
| 6  | SECTION 1. The Governor's Commission to Promote Government                                  |
| 7  | Efficiency and Savings on State Spending has recommended that administrative and            |
| 8  | support functions of State government be consolidated in areas of high concentration of     |
| 9  | State facilities, modeled after similar measures taken recently for State facilities in the |
| 10 | Morganton area. To that end, The University of North Carolina (through the Office of        |
| 11 | the President), the Judicial Branch (through the Administrative Office of the Courts),      |
| 12 | the Executive Branch (through the Department of Administration), the Legislative            |
| 13 | Branch (through the Legislative Services Office), the Community College System              |
| 14 | (through the Presidents' Office), and the Department of Public Instruction shall develop    |
| 15 | a plan to consolidate administrative functions in areas of high concentrations of State     |
| 16 | facilities. That plan shall be presented to the General Assembly no later than May 1,       |
| 17 | 2004.   |
