A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE NORTH
CAROLINA HISTORY EDUCATION CENTER AT TRYON PALACE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Cultural Resources the sum of one million seven hundred fifty-six thousand dollars (\$1,756,000) for the 2003-2004 fiscal year and the sum of one million four hundred thirty thousand dollars (\$1,430,000) for the 2004-2005 fiscal year for the development of the North Carolina History Education Center at the Tryon Palace Historic Sites and Gardens. These funds may be used for site remediation and preparation and architectural needs.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2003.
