A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO SUPPORT THE FOLIC ACID
CAMPAIGN.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services the sum of three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) for the 2003-2004 fiscal year and the sum of three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) for the 2004-2005 fiscal year. These funds shall be used to provide continuing support to the Folic Acid Campaign to prevent birth defects and infant deaths.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2003.
