**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services the sum of three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) for the 2003-2004 fiscal year and the sum of three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) for the 2004-2005 fiscal year. These funds shall be used to provide continuing support to the Folic Acid Campaign to prevent birth defects and infant deaths.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2003.
