	statement: "Caution: Federal law prohibits dispensing without
	prescription". Prescription. – An order, formula, or recipe issued orally,
	prescription: 1 rescription. This order, formula, or recipe issued ording,

<u>in writing, electronically, or by another means of transmission by a</u> physician, dentist, veterinarian, or another person licensed to prescribe

6	a. Prescription drugs. Drugs required by federal law to be
