BILL SUMMARY: The proposed bill changes the G.S. 88B-20 by establishing new fees and increasing certain current license fees under the Cosmetic Art Act.

ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY:

License Fees Overview

The NC Board of Cosmetic Art Examiners (Board) has not implemented any changes in fees for several decades. Table 1 shows the year of last fee change, current fees, proposed fees, and amounts the current fees were equal to in the year they were established, adjusted for inflation.

Revenues

Based on the above information, Table 2 provides estimates on the current annual revenue generated from issuing the licenses, anticipated annual revenue after fee increases, and annual revenue gain for the Board.

The number of cosmetology professionals will likely increase in the future, which will affect the Board revenues. However no growth estimate is available to be included in the analysis.

Expenses

The Board estimates its annual expenses as they appear in Table 3. The Board estimates annual three-percent growth in their expenses.

According to the Board, OSBM advises it to hold a minimum reserve of three months operating expenses. Based on the average monthly expenses of \$167,880, the amount of reserve would be \$503,641.

The Board plans to address the discrepancy between proposed estimated revenues (Table 2) and estimated expenses (Table 3) by charging application fees as well as late and reinstatement fees that appear in Table 1.

The proposed legislation does not affect any of the programs or departments and does not produce fiscal impact on the State.
