H 392. AMEND DEFINITION OF MALT BEVERAGE IN ABC LAW. TO AMEND THE DEFINITION OF A MALT BEVERAGE UNDER THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL LAWS. As title indicates, amends GS 18B-101(9) to remove the maximum percentage of alcohol that a beverage can contain to be defined as a malt beverage.

Amends GS 18B-101(9) to provide that in order to be defined as a malt beverage a beverage must have no more than 15% alcohol by volume. Amends GS 105-113.68(a) to delete detailed descriptions of certain terms and to instead incorporate by reference definitions set forth in GS 18B-101. Makes technical changes.
