A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE BOARD OF GREENE COUNTY
2 COMMISSIONERS MAY REQUIRE THE REGISTER OF DEEDS NOT TO
3 ACCEPT DEEDS FOR REGISTRATION UNLESS THE COUNTY TAX
4 COLLECTOR CERTIFIES THAT NO DELINQUENT TAXES ARE DUE ON
5 THAT PROPERTY.

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 161-31(b) reads as rewritten:

9 "(b) Applicability. – This section applies only to Alleghany, Anson, Beaufort,
10 Bertie, Cabarrus, Camden, Carteret, Cherokee, Chowan, Clay, Cleveland, Currituck,
11 Davidson, Duplin, Durham, Edgecombe, Forsyth, Gaston, Gates, Graham, Granville,
12 Greene, Halifax, Harnett, Haywood, Henderson, Hertford, Hyde, Iredell, Jackson, Lee,
13 Lenoir, Macon, Madison, Martin, Montgomery, Nash, Northampton, Pasquotank,
14 Pender, Perquimans, Person, Pitt, Polk, Rockingham, Rowan, Rutherford, Stanly,
15 Swain, Transylvania, Vance, Warren, Washington, Wilson, and Yadkin Counties."

16 **SECTION 2.** This act applies to Greene County only.

17 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
