A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 **PROVIDING** THAT OF AN ACT THE BOARD GREENE COUNTY 3 COMMISSIONERS MAY REQUIRE THE REGISTER OF DEEDS NOT TO 4 ACCEPT DEEDS FOR REGISTRATION UNLESS THE COUNTY TAX 5 COLLECTOR CERTIFIES THAT NO DELINQUENT TAXES ARE DUE ON 6 THAT PROPERTY. 7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 8 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 161-31(b) reads as rewritten:

- 9 "(b) Applicability. This section applies only to Alleghany, Anson, Beaufort, 10 Bertie, Cabarrus, Camden, Carteret, Cherokee, Chowan, Clay, Cleveland, Currituck, 11 Davidson, Duplin, Durham, Edgecombe, Forsyth, Gaston, Gates, Graham, Granville,
- 12 <u>Greene, Halifax, Harnett, Haywood, Henderson, Hertford, Hyde, Iredell, Jackson, Lee,</u>
- 13 Lenoir, Macon, Madison, Martin, Montgomery, Nash, Northampton, Pasquotank,
- 14 Pender, Perquimans, Person, Pitt, Polk, Rockingham, Rowan, Rutherford, Stanly,
- 15 Swain, Transylvania, Vance, Warren, Washington, Wilson, and Yadkin Counties."
- SECTION 2. This act applies to Greene County only.
- SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
