A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO REDUCE THE REQUIREMENT SO THAT ONE HUNDRED FIFTY
2 APPLICATIONS NEED TO BE RECEIVED BEFORE THE DIVISION OF
3 MOTOR VEHICLES MAY ISSUE A COUNTY COMMISSIONER SPECIAL
4 REGISTRATION PLATE.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-79.4(b)(11) reads as rewritten:

8 "(b) Types. – The Division shall issue the following types of special registration
9 plates:

10 ...
11 (11) County Commissioner. – Issuable to a county commissioner of a
12 county in this State. The plate shall bear the words "County
13 Commissioner" followed first by a number representing the
14 commissioner's county and then by a letter or number that
15 distinguishes plates issued to county commissioners of the same
16 county. The number of a county shall be the order of the county in an
17 alphabetical list of counties that assigns number one to the first county
18 in the list and a letter or number to distinguish different cars owned by
19 the county commissioners in that county. The Division may not issue
20 the plate authorized by this subdivision unless it receives at least ~~300~~
21 150 applications for the plate."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
