A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR PROMPT RELEASE OF ELECTION RESULTS AFTER THE CLOSE OF THE POLLS ON ELECTION DAY. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
SECTION 1. G.S. 163-182.2(b) reads as rewritten:		
"(b) The State Board of Elections shall promulgate rules for the initial counting of official ballots. All election officials shall be governed by those rules. In promulgating those rules, the State Board shall adhere to the following guidelines:		
(1)	For each voting system used, the rules shall specify the role officials and of the county board of elections in the initial official ballots.	•
(2)	The rules shall provide for accurate unofficial reporting of from the precinct to the county board of elections with speed on the night of the election.	
(3)	The rules shall provide for the prompt and secure tran official ballots from the voting place to the county board of

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to all primaries and elections held on or after that date.

The State Board shall direct the county boards of elections in the application of the

principles and rules in individual circumstances."
