10	The General Asse	embly of North Carolina enacts:
11	SECT	<b>ION 1.</b> G.S. 55B-2(6) reads as rewritten:
12	"(6)	The term "professional service" means any type of personal or
13		professional service of the public which requires as a condition
14		precedent to the rendering of such service the obtaining of a license
15		from a licensing board as herein defined, and pursuant to the following
16		provisions of the General Statutes: Chapter 83A, "Architects"; Chapter
17		84, "Attorneys-at-Law"; Chapter 93, "Public Accountants"; and the
18		following Articles in Chapter 90: Article 1, "Practice of Medicine,"
19		Article 2, "Dentistry," Article 6, "Optometry," Article 7, "Osteopathy,"
20		Article 8, "Chiropractic," Article 9A, "Nursing Practice Act," with
21		regard to registered nurses, Article 11, "Veterinarians," Article 12A,
22		"Podiatrists," Article 18A, "Practicing Psychologists," Article 18B,
23		"Physical Therapy," Article 18C, "Marriage and Family Therapy
24		Licensure," Article 18D, "Occupational Therapy," Article 22,
25		"Licensure Act for Speech and Language Pathologists and
26		Audiologists," and Article 24, "Licensed Professional Counselors";
27		Chapter 89C, "Engineering and Land Surveying"; Chapter 89A,

1	"Landscape Architects"; Chapter 90B, "Social Worker Certification
2	and Licensure Act" with regard to Licensed Clinical Social Workers as
3	defined by G.S. 90B-3; Chapter 89E, "Geologists"; Chapter 89B,
4	"Foresters"; and Chapter 89F, "North Carolina Soil Scientist Licensing
5	Act"."
6	<b>SECTION 2.</b> G.S. 90-270.26 is amended to add a new subdivision to read:
7	"(7a) Regulate physical therapy professional corporations pursuant to
8	Chapter 55B of the General Statutes and this Article, including
9	adopting rules for the registration of physical therapy professional
10	<u>corporations.</u> "
11	SECTION 3. Article 18B of Chapter 90 of the General Statutes is amended
12	by adding a new section to read:
13	" <u>§ 90-270.31.1. Physical therapy professional corporations.</u>
14	The Board shall not issue a certification to a professional corporation pursuant to
15	G.S. 55B-6 for the transfer of stock to an individual who is not licensed under this
16	Article unless the individual presents evidence satisfactory to the Board that the laws
17	governing or regulating physical therapy practices and professional corporations in the
18	jurisdiction where the individual is duly licensed and performs physical therapy
19	professional services are equivalent to, or require a higher standard than, the provisions
20	of this Article and Chapter 55B of the General Statutes."
21	SECTION 4. G.S. 90-270.35 is amended by adding a new subdivision to
22	read:
23	"(4a) Practice physical therapy and make physical therapy patient treatment
24	decisions based on corporate or business standards or parameters
25	rather than on the best interest of the patient in the physical therapist's
26	sound professional judgment;".
27	<b>SECTION 5.</b> G.S. 90-270.36 is amended by adding a new subdivision to
28	read:
29	"(6a) Violation of G.S. 90-401 by financially compensating or rewarding
30	another person, firm, or corporation for recommending, arranging, or
31	securing employment by a patient."
32	<b>SECTION 6.</b> This act becomes effective January 1, 2006, and applies to acts
33	occurring or offenses committed on or after that date.
