5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1. G.S. 113-291.1(d1) reads as rewritten:
7	"(d1) Except in areas closed to protect sensitive wildlife populations, and subject to
8	conditions and restrictions contained in rules of the Wildlife Resources Commission,
9	hunters may train dogs during the closed season:
10	(1) With the use of approved-weapons and ammunition; and ammunition
11	approved by the Wildlife Resources Commission;
12	(2) If reasonable control is exercised to prevent the dogs from running
13	unsupervised at large and from killing wild animals and wild birds.
14	<u>birds;</u>
15	(3) On land owned or leased by the dog trainer or upon which the person
16	has written permission to train dogs; and
17	(4) Using artificially propagated waterfowl and game birds, provided the
18	birds are marked and sources are documented as required by the
19	Wildlife Resources Commission."
20	SECTION 2. At its first meeting after this act becomes law, the Wildlife
21	Resources Commission shall initiate rule making to implement provisions of this act to
22	regulate dog training. Until the rules become effective, persons may participate in dog
23	training activities for retrievers and bird dogs as permitted by G.S. 113-291.1(d1), as
24	amended by this act, using shotguns and nontoxic shot of #4 size or smaller and using
25	only domestically propagated waterfowl and game birds that have been obtained and
26	marked as currently set forth in 15A NCAC 10B.0114.
27	SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
