SECTION 1. Article 12 of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

"§ 160A-280. Donations of property to other local governments.

- (a) A city or a county may donate to another governmental unit any real property or personal property, including supplies, materials, and equipment, that the governing board deems to be surplus, obsolete, or unused. The governing board of the city or county shall give public notice and shall adopt a resolution approving the donation prior to making any donation of surplus, obsolete, or unused property.
- (b) For the purposes of this section, the term 'governmental unit' shall have the same meaning as defined by G.S. 160A-274(a)."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
