| The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: |
| SECTION 1. Article 12 of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes is amended |
| by adding a new section to read: |
| "§ 160A-280. Donations of personal property to other local governments. |
| (a) A city or a county may donate to another governmental unit any personal |
| property, including supplies, materials, and equipment, that the governing board deems |
| to be surplus, obsolete, or unused. The governing board of the city or county shall post a |
| public notice at least five days prior to the adoption of a resolution approving the |
| donation. The resolution shall be adopted prior to making any donation of surplus, |
| obsolete, or unused personal property. |
| (b) For the purposes of this section, the term 'governmental unit' shall have the |
| same meaning as defined by G.S. 160A-274(a)." |
| SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law. |
