The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
<b>SECTION 1.</b> Article 12 of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes is amended	
by adding a new section to read:	
"§ 160A-280. Donations of personal property to other governmental un	<u>its.</u>
(a) A city or a county may donate to another governmental unit a	any personal
property, including supplies, materials, and equipment, that the governing	board deems
to be surplus, obsolete, or unused. The governing board of the city or county	<u>y shall post a</u>
public notice at least five days prior to the adoption of a resolution approving the	
donation. The resolution shall be adopted prior to making any donation of surplus,	

obsolete, or unused personal property. 14

## For the purposes of this section, the term 'governmental unit' shall have the 15 (b) same meaning as defined by G.S. 160A-274(a) and includes charter schools. 16

- The authority granted to a city, county, or governmental unit under this 17 (c) section is in addition to any authority granted under any other provision of law." 18
- **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law. 19
