13	<u>(1)</u>	'Claim' means any claim by, or on behalf of, a natural person, as well
14		as any derivative or other claim arising from such claim asserted by or
15		on behalf of any other person.
16	<u>(2)</u>	'Food' has the meaning set forth in section 201(f) of the federal Food,
17		Drug, and Cosmetic Act, 21 U.S.C. § 321(f), as amended.
18	<u>(3)</u>	'Generally known condition caused by or likely to result from
19		long-term consumption' means a condition generally known to result
20		or to likely result from the cumulative effect of consumption, and not
21		from a single instance of consumption.
22	<u>(4)</u>	'Knowing and willful violation' means that the conduct constituting the
23		violation was committed with the intent to deceive or injure consumers
24		or with actual knowledge that such conduct was injurious to

consumers; and the conduct constituting the violation was not required by any regulation, order, rule, or other pronouncement of, or any

statute administered by a State, federal, or local government agency.

1 (5) 'Law of this State' means any statute, regulation, rule, common law,
2 public policy, court or administrative decision or decree, or other any
3 State action having the effect of law.

(6) 'Other person' means any individual, corporation, company, association, firm, partnership, society, joint-stock company, or any other entity, including any governmental entity or private attorney general.

"§ 99E-35. Immunity for purveyors of food products.

Subject to G.S. 99E-40, a manufacturer, packer, distributor, carrier, holder, seller, marketer, or advertiser of a food, or an association of one or more such entities, shall not be subject to civil liability arising under any law of this State for any claim arising out of weight gain, obesity, a health condition associated with weight gain or obesity, or other generally known condition caused by or likely to result from long-term consumption of food.

"§ 99E-40. Exemption.

- (a) The provisions of G.S. 99E-35 do not preclude civil liability when the claim of weight gain, obesity, health condition associated with weight gain or obesity, or other generally known condition caused by or likely to result from long-term consumption of food satisfies either of the following:
 - (1) The claim includes as an element of the cause of action a material violation of an adulteration or misbranding requirement prescribed by State or federal statute, rule, or regulation, and the injury was proximately caused by the violation.
 - (2) The claim is based on all of the following:
 - a. A material violation of a State or federal law that applies to the manufacturing, marketing, distribution, advertising, labeling, or sale of food other than a claim under subdivision (1) of this subsection.
 - <u>b.</u> The violation of the State or federal law is knowing and willful.
 - c. The injury was proximately caused by the violation.
- (b) Nothing in subsection (a) of this section shall be construed to create new, or expand existing, private rights, if any, under the adulteration or misbranding State or federal statutes, rules, or regulations, nor shall subsection (a) of this section be construed to interfere with any agency's exclusive or primary jurisdiction to find or declare violations of such statutes, rules, or regulations.

"§ 99E-45. Pleading requirements.

In any action subject to liability under subdivision (1) of subsection (a) of G.S. 99E-40, the complaint shall state with particularity all the following:

- (1) The State or federal statute, rule, or regulation that was allegedly violated.
- (2) The facts that constitute a material violation of the State or federal statute, rule, or regulation.
- (3) The facts that demonstrate that the violation proximately caused actual injury to the plaintiff.
