5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1. The Legislative Research Commission may study issues
7	related to use and regulation of complementary and alternative forms of medicine in this
8	State. If this study is undertaken, the Commission shall examine the following issues:
9	(1) Types of complementary and alternative health care services currently
10	being offered and used in North Carolina.
11	(2) Ways to remove current restrictions and facilitate access of consumers
12	to complementary and alternative health care practitioners who are
13	providing health care services not currently covered by existing
14	medical licensing laws.
15	(3) The impact of Health Freedom legislation in other states including
16	Oklahoma, Minnesota, Rhode Island, California, and Idaho.
17	(4) Any other matter that the Commission deems appropriate or necessary
18	to provide proper information to the General Assembly on the subject
19	of the study.
20	SECTION 2. The Commission may report to the 2006 Regular Session of
21	the 2005 General Assembly or to the 2007 General Assembly on its findings and may
22	make any legislative recommendations it considers appropriate.
23	SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
