2	AN ACT REQUIRING CITIES TO FILE CERTIFIED CHARTERS AND
3	BOUNDARY MAPS AND COUNTIES TO FILE CERTIFIED BOUNDARY AND
4	TOWNSHIP MAPS WITH THE SECRETARY OF STATE.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1. G.S. 160A-22 reads as rewritten:
7	"§ 160A-22. Map of corporate limits.
8	(a) The current city boundaries shall at all times be drawn on a map, or set out in
9	a written description, or shown by a combination of these techniques. This delineation
10	shall be retained permanently in the office of the city clerk. Alterations in these
11	established boundaries shall be indicated by appropriate entries upon or additions to the
12	map or description made by or under the direction of the officer charged with that duty
13	by the city charter or by the council. Copies of the map or description reproduced by
14	any method of reproduction that gives legible and permanent copies, when certified by
15	the city clerk, shall be admissible in evidence in all courts and shall have the same force
16	and effect as would the original map or description. The council may provide for
17	revisions in any map or other description of the city boundaries. A revised map or
18	description shall supersede for all purposes the earlier map or description that it is
19	designated to replace.
20	(b) On or before July 1, 2006, the city clerk shall file with the Secretary of State a
21	certified map showing the boundaries of the city as they existed on January 1, 2006.
22	Thereafter, on or before July 1 of the year preceding each decennial federal census, the
23	city clerk shall file with the Secretary of State a certified map showing the boundaries of
24	the city as they existed on January 1 of the year preceding the decennial federal census.
25	All maps required by this subsection shall conform with rules prescribed by the
26	Secretary of State."
27	SECTION 2. G.S. 160A-111 reads as rewritten:

1	"§ 160A-111. Filing certified true copies of charter <u>charters</u> and charter
2	amendments.
3	(a) On or before July 1, 2006, the city clerk shall file with the Secretary of State a
4	certified true copy of the city's charter as it appeared on January 1, 2006. Thereafter, on
5	or before July 1 of the year preceding each decennial federal census, the city clerk shall
6	file with the Secretary of State a certified true copy of the city's charter as it appeared on
7	January 1 of the year preceding the decennial federal census.
8	(b) The city clerk shall file a certified true copy of any charter amendment
9	adopted under this Part with the Secretary of State and the Legislative Library."
10	SECTION 3. G.S. 153A-17 reads as rewritten:
11	"§ 153A-17. Existing boundaries.
12	(a) The boundaries of each county shall remain as presently established, until
13	changed in accordance with law.
14	(b) On or before July 1, 2006, the county manager or, where there is no county
15	manager, the chairman of the board of commissioners, shall file with the Secretary of
16	State a certified map showing the boundaries of the county as they existed on January 1,
17	2006. Thereafter, on or before July 1 of the year preceding each decennial federal
18	census, the manager or chairman shall file with the Secretary of State a certified map
19	showing the boundaries of the county as they existed on January 1 of the year preceding
20	the decennial federal census. All maps required by this subsection shall conform with
21	rules prescribed by the Secretary of State."
22	SECTION 4. G.S. 153A-19 is amended by adding the following new
23	subsection to read:
24	§ 153A-19. Establishing and naming townships.
25	
26	(d) On or before July 1, 2006, the county manager or, where there is no county
27	manager, the chairman of the board of commissioners, shall file with the Secretary of
28	State a certified map showing the boundaries and names of all townships within the
29	county on January 1, 2006. Thereafter, or before July 1 of the year preceding each
30	decennial federal census, the manager or chairman shall file with the Secretary of State
31	a certified map showing the boundaries and names of all townships within the county on
32	January 1 of the year preceding the decennial federal census. The manager or chairman
33	shall report changes in township boundaries to the Secretary of State. All maps required
34	by this subsection shall conform with rules prescribed by the Secretary of State."
35	SECTION 5. This act is effective when it becomes law.
