**SECTION 1.** G.S. 115C-296 is amended by adding a new subsection to

"(b2) An undergraduate student seeking a degree in teacher education must satisfactorily complete a preprofessional skills test that assesses reading, writing, and mathematics competencies prior to admission to an approved teacher education program in a North Carolina college or university. The State Board of Education shall permit students to fulfill this requirement by satisfactorily completing any one of the following tests:

- 13 <u>(1) The Praxis I Test.</u>
- 14 (2) The SAT Test.
