2	AN ACT TO INCREASE THE PROCESSING FEE FOR RETURNED CHECKS.
3	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
4	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 25-3-506 reads as rewritten:
5	"§ 25-3-506. Collection of processing fee for returned checks.
6	A person who accepts a check in payment for goods or services or his assignee may
7	charge and collect a processing fee, not to exceed twenty-five dollars (\$25.00), thirty
8	dollars (\$30.00), for a check on which payment has been refused by the payor bank
9	because of insufficient funds or because the drawer did not have an account at that bank.
10	If a collection agency collects or seeks to collect on behalf of its principal a
11	processing fee as specified in this section in addition to the sum payable of a check, the
12	amount of such processing fee must be separately stated on the collection notice. The
13	collection agency shall not collect or seek to collect from the drawer any sum other than
14	the actual amount of the returned check and the specified processing fee."
15	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2005, and applies to
16	fees charged on or after that date.
