2 AN ACT TO MAKE THE LAW GOVERNING THE COMMERCIAL
3 TRANSPORTATION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES CONSISTENT WITH THE
4 LAW GOVERNING THE AMOUNTS OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES THAT
5 MAY BE PURCHASED WITHOUT A PERMIT.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 18B-1115(a) reads as rewritten:

8 "(a) Permit Required. – Unless a person holds a permit which otherwise allows
9 him to transport more than 80 liters of malt beverages other than draft malt beverages in
10 kegs, ~~20-50~~ 50 liters of unfortified wine, or eight liters of fortified wine or spirituous liquor,
11 or is a retailer authorized to transport alcoholic beverages under G.S. 18B-405, each
12 person transporting alcoholic beverages in excess of those quantities shall have the
13 permit described in this section."

14 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
