7	SE	<b>CTION 1.</b> G.S. 14-404(a) reads as rewritten:
8	"(a) Up	on application, the sheriff shall issue the license or permit to a resident of
9	that county unless the purpose of the permit is for collecting, in which case a sheriff can	
10	issue a permit to a nonresident when the sheriff has done all of the following:	
11	(1)	Verified by a criminal history background investigation that it is not a
12		violation of State or federal law for the applicant to purchase, transfer,
13		receive, or possess a handgun. The sheriff shall determine the criminal
14		history of any applicant by accessing computerized criminal history
15		records as maintained by the State Bureau of Investigation and the
16		Federal Bureau of Investigation, by conducting a national criminal
17		history records check, and by conducting a criminal history check
18		through the Administrative Office of the Courts.

20		otherwise, as to the good moral character of the applicant.
21	(3)	Fully satisfied himself or herself that the applicant desires the
22		possession of the weapon mentioned for (i) the protection of the home,
23		business, person, family or property, (ii) target shooting, (iii)
