AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR AN ADDITIONAL ASSISTANT
DISTRICT ATTORNEY AND THREE VICTIM WITNESS LEGAL
ASSISTANTS FOR PROSECUTORIAL DISTRICT 20.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 7A-60(a1) reads as rewritten:

"(a1) The counties of the State are organized into prosecutorial districts, and each district has the counties and the number of full-time assistant district attorneys set forth in the following table:

39 **SECTION 2.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial
40 Department the sum of eighty-two thousand two hundred fifty-three dollars (\$82,253)
41 for the 2005-2006 fiscal year and the sum of seventy-eight thousand one hundred
42 fifty-four dollars (\$78,154) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish a new assistant
43 district attorney position in Prosecutorial District 20.

1 **SECTION 3.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial
2 Department the sum of one hundred thirty-nine thousand seven hundred seventy-nine
3 dollars (\$139,779) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year and the sum of one hundred thirty
4 thousand twenty-nine dollars (\$130,029) to establish three new victim witness legal
5 assistants in Prosecutorial District 20.

6 **SECTION 4.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
