SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial Department the sum of eighty-two thousand two hundred fifty-three dollars (\$82,253) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year and the sum of seventy-eight thousand one hundred fifty-four dollars (\$78,154) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish a new assistant district attorney position in Prosecutorial District 20.

SECTION 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial Department the sum of one hundred thirty-nine thousand seven hundred seventy-nine dollars (\$139,779) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year and the sum of one hundred thirty

- thousand twenty-nine dollars (\$130,029) to establish three new victim witness legal
- 2 assistants in Prosecutorial District 20.
- 3 **SECTION 4.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
