Short Title: District 24 ADA/Victim Witness Funds.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR TWO ADDITIONAL ASSISTANT DISTRICT ATTORNEYS AND TWO ADDITIONAL VICTIM WITNESS LEGAL ASSISTANTS FOR PROSECUTORIAL DISTRICT 24.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 7A-60(a1) reads as rewritten:

"(a1) The counties of the State are organized into prosecutorial districts, and each district has the counties and the number of full-time assistant district attorneys set forth in the following table:
