A HOUSE RESOLUTION URGING CONGRESS TO ENACT LEGISLATION 1 2 PERTAINING TO SMALL BUSINESS HEALTH PLANS. 3 Whereas, for years, the main concern for small business owners has been to 4 provide affordable health insurance for their employees; and 5 Whereas, of the 27 million working people who are uninsured, 63% of them are either self-employed or work for a small business that employs less than 100 people; 6 7 and 8 Whereas, lack of competition and soaring administrative costs contribute to 9 the inability of small businesses to provide health insurance for their employees; and Whereas, uniform federal regulation of small business health plans would 10 benefit small business owners, making health insurance more affordable and providing 11 12 small business owners with greater health insurance options; and Whereas, pending legislation before the United States Congress, the Small 13 Business Health Fairness Act of 2005 (H.R. 525/S. 406), would provide for the 14 establishment and governance of association health plans (also known as small business 15 health plans), which are group health plans whose sponsors are trade, industry, 16 professional, chamber of commerce, or similar business associations and which meet 17 certain Employee Retirement Income Security Act (ERISA) certification requirements; 18 19 and 20 Whereas, the legislation would allow health insurance issuers to offer coverage of the same policy type offered in connection with a particular association 21 22 health plan to eligible employers, regardless of whether the employers are members of the particular association and regardless of State law; and 23 Whereas, small business plans would level the playing field and give 24 participating small employers the same buying power as Fortune 500 companies and 25 26 unions; and 27 Whereas, the Small Business Health Fairness Act of 2005 has bipartisan 28 support; Now, therefore,

1	Be it resolved by the House of Representatives:
2	SECTION 1. The North Carolina House of Representatives urges Congress
3	to enact the Small Business Health Fairness Act of 2005 or similar legislation.
4	SECTION 2. The Principal Clerk shall transmit a certified copy of this
5	resolution to each member of North Carolina's congressional delegation.
