A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR A LEGISLATIVE PAY INCREASE OF SEVEN PERCENT FOR ALL PUBLIC SCHOOL, COMMUNITY COLLEGE, AND STATE EMPLOYEES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1**. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Reserve for Compensation Increases the sum of seven hundred eleven million twenty-five thousand dollars (\$711,025,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to provide for a seven percent (7%) legislative pay increase across the board for public school, community college, and State employees.

**SECTION 2.** There is appropriated from the Highway Fund to the Reserve for Compensation Increases the sum of thirty-three million five hundred sixteen thousand dollars (\$33,516,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to provide for a seven percent (7%) legislative pay increase across the board for public school, community college, and State employees.

**SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
