6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** G.S. 7A-133(a) reads as rewritten:

## "§ 7A-133. Numbers of judges by districts; numbers of magistrates and additional seats of court, by counties.

**SECTION 2.** The Governor shall appoint the two additional district court judges for District 10 authorized by this act, and those judges' successors shall be elected in the 2008 election for four-year terms commencing on the first Monday in December 2008.

## **SECTION 3.** G.S. 7A-60(a1) reads as rewritten:

"(a1) The counties of the State are organized into prosecutorial districts, and each district has the counties and the number of full-time assistant district attorneys set forth in the following table:

**SECTION 4.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial Department the sum of one hundred seventy-eight thousand three hundred forty-four dollars (\$178,344) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish the two additional district court judgeships for District Court District 10 authorized by this act.

**SECTION 5.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial Department the sum of eighty-four thousand six hundred ninety-six dollars (\$84,696) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish the additional assistant district attorney position for Prosecutorial District 10 authorized by this act.

**SECTION 6.** Sections 1 and 2 of this act become effective December 15, 2006. The remainder of this act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
