A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ESTABLISH TWO ADDITIONAL DISTRICT COURT JUDGES IN DISTRICT COURT DISTRICT 10 AND ONE ADDITIONAL ASSISTANT DISTRICT ATTORNEY IN PROSECUTORIAL DISTRICT 10.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 7A-133(a) reads as rewritten:

"§ 7A-133. Numbers of judges by districts; numbers of magistrates and additional seats of court, by counties.

(a) Each district court district shall have the numbers of judges as set forth in the following table:

1 **SECTION 2.** The Governor shall appoint the two additional district court
2 judges for District 10 authorized by this act, and those judges' successors shall be
3 elected in the 2008 election for four-year terms commencing on the first Monday in
4 December 2008.

5 **SECTION 3.** G.S. 7A-60(a1) reads as rewritten:

6 "(a1) The counties of the State are organized into prosecutorial districts, and each
7 district has the counties and the number of full-time assistant district attorneys set forth

21 **SECTION 4.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial
 22 Department the sum of one hundred seventy-eight thousand three hundred forty-four
 23 dollars (\$178,344) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish the two additional district
 24 court judgeships for District Court District 10 authorized by this act.

25 **SECTION 5.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial
 26 Department the sum of eighty-four thousand six hundred ninety-six dollars (\$84,696)
 27 for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish the additional assistant district attorney
 28 position for Prosecutorial District 10 authorized by this act.

29 **SECTION 6.** Sections 1 and 2 of this act become effective December 15,
 30 2006. The remainder of this act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
